



NASHVILLE POST S.A.M.E. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM DETAILS 2009 – 2010 Academic Year

Purpose: To encourage and assist qualified students who wish to pursue a college education in the field of engineering, architecture, mathematics, computer science, or related field so that they, in turn, might further the mission, vision, and values of S.A.M.E.

Terms: Scholarships up to \$2500 for academic year 2009 – 2010. The scholarship must be used during the 2009 - 2010 academic year.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. A current member of the SAME Nashville Post (SAME-NP), son/daughter or grandson/granddaughter of an active or deceased member of the SAME-NP; where active member is defined as being a current member (at the time of the application) who has held current membership for one continuous year or more; student member of the SAME-NP; son/daughter or grandson/granddaughter of an employee of a current SAME Nashville Post sustaining member firm (see www.SAMENashvillePost.org for sustaining member list; the Corps of Engineers is considered a sustaining member firm); or employee of current sustaining member firm.
2. Be a college student (undergraduate or graduate) or graduating high school senior.
3. Minimum current grade point average of 3.0 (B) on a 4.0 scale.
4. Accepted by or attending an accredited college or university studying engineering, architecture, mathematics, computer science or related fields of study.

Selection Criteria:

1. Graduating high school applicants: SAT or ACT test results.
2. Grade point average.
3. Recommendation by advisor and/or instructor.
4. Required major in architecture, engineering, mathematics, computer science or related field.
5. Evidence of serious scholastic attitude, good character, leadership qualities, and well-rounded personal development.
6. Preference to students with military aspirations as exemplified by enrollment in Officer Training program or previous military service.
7. Studies, activities, and work that represent SAME's mission, vision, and values.

2009 Schedule:

February 16 - April 17: Applications accepted.
June 30-July 14: Notification of awards to scholarship recipients.
August 1-14: Distribution of scholarship funds (directly to university).

Filling in the Application:

The application, transcripts, and references letters must be postmarked by April 17, 2009 for the application to be considered.
